Q Where is your mother? A She is dead. Q Where in China is your father? A Har Loo, Hen Low. Q Have you any papers showing your birth in the United States? A (Presents certificate of identity No. 7000 issued to Henry Pean, (Chiu Hing Lee at Vancouver. B. C., July 18, 1912, by John L. Zurbrick, Immigration Official in Charge.) Q Through what port do you intend to depart? A Vancouver. 2 Are you married? A Yes.

Q Where is your wife living at the present time? Har Loo, Hen Lew. Was your wife ever in the United States? No. Have you smy children? One boy, Jew Jon, S.

Q Do you read and write the English language? A little. ? You speak it some? Have you ever been a witness in this office or any immigration office or court in a Chinese case?
