DESCRIPTION: Age 30; height 5' 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "; faint scar right cheek bone; faint scar lower left cheek; mole right of neck; scars outer side left forefinger; occupation, house-wife; destined to New York City; family name Jung; speaks no English.

Applicant sworn, testified as follows:

INSPECTOR: Q What are your names?

APPLICANT: A Jung Shee. Mrs. Chiu Hing Lee. Jung Gun Gee was my full maiden name.

Q You applied at Vancouver, did you not, in August, 1916, for admission to the United States?

A Yes.

Q Why did you return to China that time?

A On account of eye trouble.

Q Was all the testimony you gave at that time true?

A Yes.

Q Have you any photographs of yourself?

A Yes (Presents same).

Q What other name has your husband?

A Chiu Ying Nom is his marriage name (Identifies photograph of husband on Vancouver 634).

Q How many children have you at the present time?

A Only one boy, no girls. The boy's name is Chiu Jun Woot, born 15th day, 12th month, he is now 5 years old. He is now living with my husband's father in Har Loo village, Sun Woi Dist., China.

Q Do you know anyone in that village named Chiu Quon On?

A Yes, he is now in my village where I lived in China.

Q Where is his house there?

A It is the 6th house in our row. The 6th lot is vacant, his house is on the 7th lot.

Q Do you know the names of the ancestral halls in your village?

A There is a Chiu family ancestral hall, I dont know the name.

Q Do you know Chiu Hor Foo?

A I know him, he lives across the lane from our house.

Q Is he married?

A He is married but has no children.

Q Are you sure he is married?

A Yes.

Q When did he marry?

A I dont know when he married.

Q If your husband says he is unmarried, is he wrong?
